

Water Billing Policy

On the <u>second Tuesday</u> of the month of January, April, July, and October the meters will be read.

On the <u>third Monday</u> all meter bills will be mailed out during the month of January, April, July, and October.

Thirty (30) days after the bills have been mailed out the bill is due. This date can be found on the current bill.

On the day after the bills are due all penalties and interest shall begin to accrue on the unpaid balance.

Sixty days after the due date of each billing cycle will be known as the cutoff date for any delinquent account. If the bill remains unpaid thirty (30) days after the due date the tenant or property owner will be sent a notice of delinquency and informed that penalties and interest will be applied. Ten (10) days prior to the sixty-day cutoff date a cutoff notice will be sent to the tenant, or property owner advising them that in the absence of payments of all charges, penalties, and interest that their service will be disconnected on said date. The cutoff notice will be sent to the Property Owner or Tenant (10) days business day prior to the cutoff date.

All meters that are turned off shall then pay the current reconnect fee, all penalties, interest, past due bills prior to service being re-instated.
